Serving units and keeping them healthy, active, and effective are among the most important responsibilities in Scouting. Commissioners are able to do these tasks best when they are trained for the job.

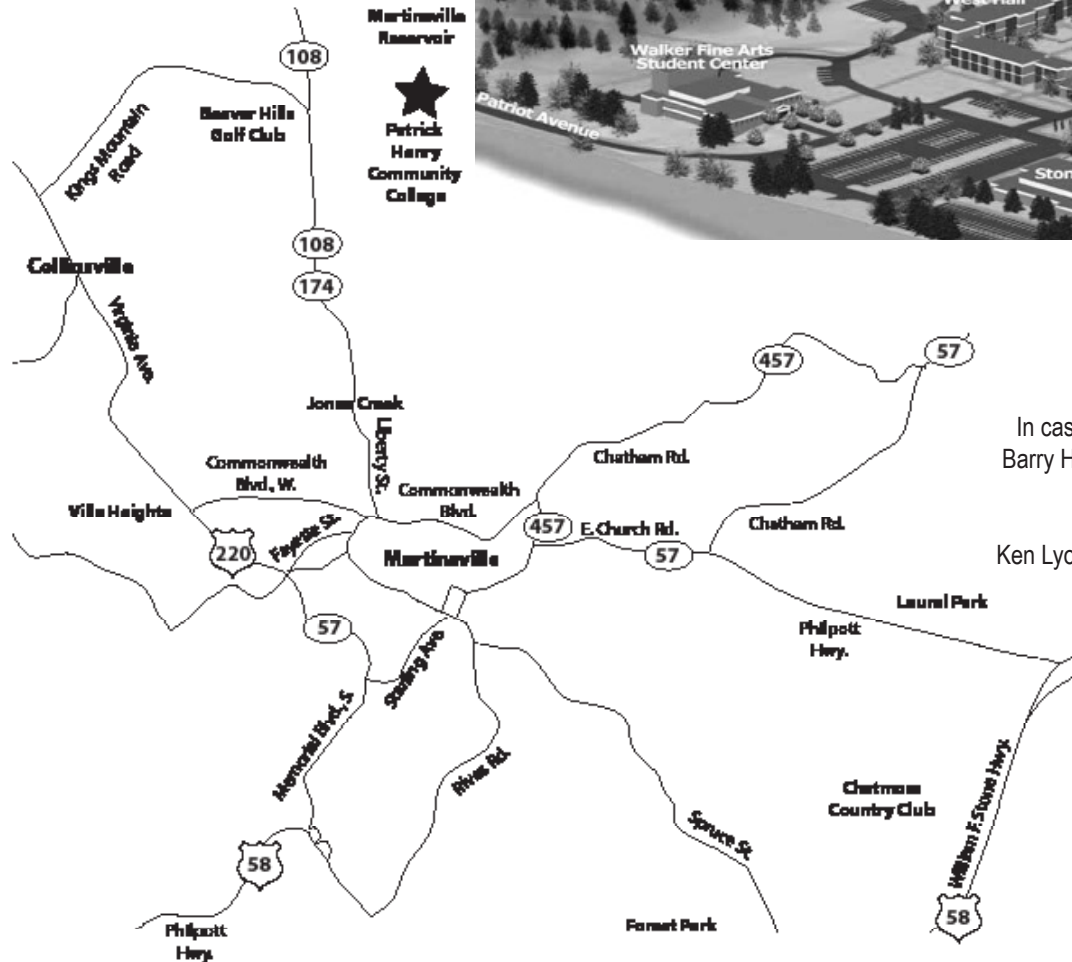

From Roanoke
Take US 220 South to the Collinsville/Martinsville exit. Turning right, follow Virginia Avenue (Business 220) under the overpass into Collinsville. Turn left onto Kings Mountain Road at the first stop light. At the third stop-light, turn left on to College Drive. Turn right on to Patriot Avenue at the campus entrance sign.

From Greensboro
Take 40 W to 68N (Piedmont Triad Int. Airport exit). Route 68 becomes 220 N after you travel about 15 miles. Continue on 220 N Business - do not take by-pass. Take a right on to Commonwealth Boulevard (across from Wal-Mart). Take a left at the 5th stop light on to Liberty Street (Rt. 174). Go approximately 3 miles and take a right at the 3rd stop light on to College Drive. Turn right on to Patriot Avenue at the campus entrance sign. Welcome to Patrick Henry Community College!
