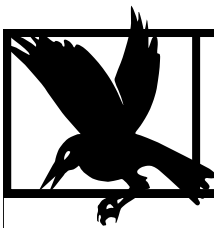

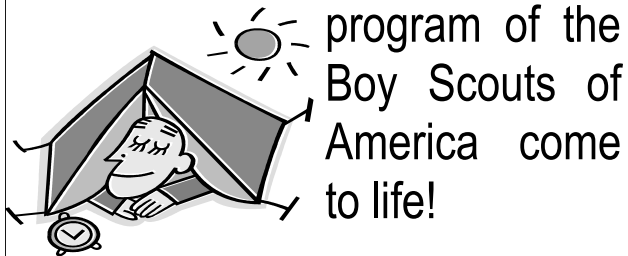


The course is also ideal for **Venturing** leaders since it focuses on skills that build confidence and competence in leaders conducting outdoor camping experiences.
