ELIGIBILITY: All registered Tiger Cubs, Cub's & Webelos

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: June 1, 2010
(Late fee of \$10 up to June 11th)

NO REGISTRATIONS ACCEPTED AFTER JUNE 11

LOCATION: Speas Elementary School, 2000 Polo Rd.

DRESS: Shorts/pants, Camp Tee Shirt (provided), socks/shoes

* NO open-toed shoes or Croc-type shoes allowed

*Swim shorts required on swim days

Lunch: Send a **BAG LUNCH** for your Scout each day
Pack lunch in a gallon zip loc bag.
EXCEPT for WEDNESDAY PIZZA DAY !

Camp Fees and Information

COST: \$60.00 per registered scout (if paid by June 1st)

\$70.00 per registered scout (from June 2nd-11th)

NOTE: NO ON-SITE REGISTRATIONS THIS YEAR

STAFF DISCOUNTS: Work all 5 full days – FREE (1st scout only)
(Discounts do not apply for chaperons)

MULTI-CHILD DISCOUNTS:
\$60.00 first scout, \$55.00 each additional scout - (Maximum of three)

COST INCLUDES: Camper insurance, crafts, program materials, patches, t-shirts, awards/specialty items, swimming*, Day Camp backpack and the Friday Closing Day Camp Ceremony activities. *Swimming - Scouts will need to come to camp in their swim shorts/trunks on swim days. They won't be allowed to swim in "street" clothes. They will also need to bring a towel and sunscreen to be applied on scout prior to arrival on swim day(s). The Camp will provide PIZZA for lunch on Wednesday. **Beverage will be provided daily.**

PIXIE CAMP: A special camp program for the little ones (ages 2 to 11) of registered staff members **ONLY**. Smaller children need to be potty trained, and no one over age 11 is allowed.

PROGRAM ACTIVITIES: All kinds of fun Cub Scout activities have been planned in the areas of crafts, nature, music, games, swimming, shooting sports and archery. The boys will get the opportunity to earn several belt loops and work on many of their rank-specific achievements. Attendance is required to earn these awards. Friday we will have an Ice Cream Party and the Closing Day Camp Ceremonies beginning at 4:00 pm.

CHAPERONS and STAFF The success of our camp is directly related to the commitment of our full-time staff and chaperons that help our scouts have the best program available. Day Camp standards require that appropriate staff and chaperon ratios be maintained during the camp program. ***One chaperon for Every Five Scouts Daily.*** A chaperon is an adult 21 years or older, usually a parent/guardian of an attending scout who volunteers for one or more days to help supervise the scouts in a particular den. It is not required that the same chaperon come each day. There just needs to be one chaperon to each group of five scouts each day. A chaperon does not receive discounts on camp fees or receive a camp t-shirt.

All scout day camp applications must be turned in through your Pack due to chaperon requirements.

Pack Day Camp Coordinator

Each pack sending scouts to day camp needs to designate one person to act as their Pack Day Camp Coordinator. The Pack Day Camp Coordinator is our contact point with your pack. The Pack Day Camp Coordinator is responsible for making sure the registration information for each scout is correct and complete, collecting the fees, and registering the Pack at the council office. They also ensure that the pack has the appropriate number of chaperons at camp each day.

Pack Day Camp Registration

Coordination of day camp registration is not a trivial matter; there are a myriad of details that must be completed properly in order for a pack to register. This year we have a full time registrar, Barbie Morgan, who can assist you in registering your scouts. Call Barbie at 336-813-5206 for help and information. Also, ALL BSA REGISTERED LEADERS AND STAFF at day camp MUST have a current Youth Protection Certificate. You can take this training online at www.oldhickorycouncil.org.

Designating Chaperons

The Day Camp Coordinator is responsible for ensuring that the pack has ***one chaperon for every five scouts attending camp each day***. The pack registration form includes spaces next to each group of five scouts to list the responsible chaperon each day.

A chaperon is an adult 21 years or older, usually a parent/guardian of an attending scout that volunteer for one or more days to help supervise all scouts in a particular den. It is not required that the same chaperon attend each day. Chaperons do not receive discounts on camp fees and do not receive camp t-shirts, though they will be able to purchase t-shirts by contacting the Camp Program Director.

Registration and Payment of Fees

The Day Camp Coordinator will need to collect the individual registration fees, scout registration/medical forms, staff application/medical forms, chaperon registration/medical forms and turn them in with their pack registration form (s) at the Old Hickory Council office ***by Monday, June 1, 2010***. Packs registering after this date will have to pay a \$10 per scout late charge **up to June 11, 2010**.

No registrations accepted after June 11, 2010.**
