- Everyone (including adults) should stay out of the yellow tape/ roped off areas!

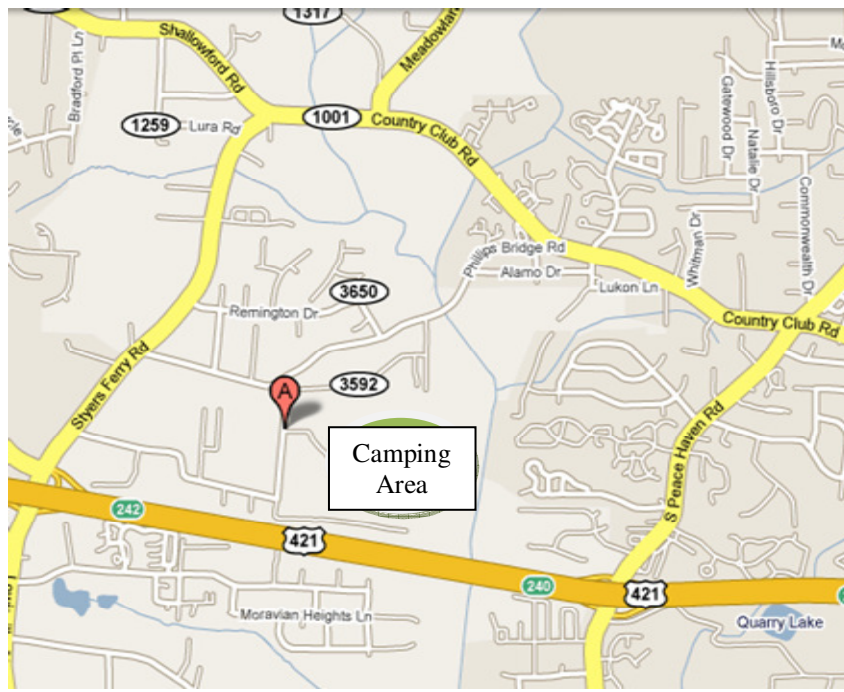
## Event Registration and Admission Fees

- **Registration for all campers** is \$10.00 and due by October 16, 2009 at the council office. After this date, registration will be \$12.00. **Important: Bring a copy of your receipt from the council office to show that payment was made.** Last date to make payment at the council office is Thursday, October 22, 2009 (remember that payment after October 16 is late). Please make payment in the form of a check made out to Old Hickory Council, BSA.
- Please park in designated parking areas ONLY.

He will be on-site, so remember that he will not be answering calls and this message will simply serve to provide information in the case that the weather is questionable. ## Camporee Food

Meals will be the responsibility of the patrols. The Patrol Method will be used throughout this event. Get your patrol duty rosters ready.

- **NOTE: Registration fee for this event INCLUDES one fish per Scout(er)!!\***
- *\*[If you do not care for fish, hot dogs will be available or you may bring something else for Saturday dinner]*
- **Important: Troops should bring their own water for cooking and drinking.** We are working to get a water trailer but it is not confirmed as of yet and troops should plan to bring their own water just in case.
- Patrols should plan for:
  - Friday Dinner (Depending on arrival)
  - Saturday Breakfast
  - Saturday Lunch
  - Saturday Dinner (**Remember we will be providing the fish, you need to provide everything else**)
  - Sunday Breakfast

## Participation Details

- All participants should **register**. Deadline for registration will be Friday, October 16, 2009.
- Morning Sessions run from 9:00 AM until 12 noon; Afternoon sessions run from 1:00 PM until 3:30PM.
- Campfire Saturday night is at 8:00PM
- **All scouts should be assigned to be in a Patrol as the Camporee events, demonstrations and activities are setup to utilize this method. The unit registration has room for this designation (there is a place to write in the patrol names and you are to list the names of each Scout under their patrol name).**
- Patrol Scorecards will be distributed at the Unit Leader Meeting Friday night
- Patrol Leaders will be responsible to turn their Scorecard in at the Registration Tent after the events have ended Saturday afternoon ~3:30PM

## Camping Rules

- All Camping is done by unit
- On-time Camping Cost is \$10.00/camper, which includes a patch, insurance and a full day of activities
- Our camping facility will be 943 Ridings Road, Lewisville NC. (See Map)
- Units are encouraged to arrive together. Water will be available.
- **Fires are permitted. Please replace turf or use strike pans or raised barrels.** Fires will also be subject to weather conditions at that time- according to the opinion of the Camporee Director, Glenn Chamberlin, and the Administrators of Camporee.
- Saturday night will feature a Campfire that is open to all registered participants.
- Units are encouraged to plan a skit, song, joke or story. All such campfire entertainment must be approved in advance by the campfire committee (Order of the Arrow).
