**OC1 Dutch Oven I \$8.00 (Basic) Bob Seahausen 2 Session course AM only**

This is a classroom and outdoor course. If you have never cooked with a Dutch oven, this course is for you. From the care of your cast iron appliances, to the meals that can be prepared in a Dutch oven, basic recipes, tricks with a Dutch oven, cooking and eating are the goals of this course. This course is limited to 18 leaders. The course runs through session 1 & 2. Register early. An extra fee of \$8.00 will be added to your registration. Leaders in this course will eat what is prepared by both DO teams.

**OC2 Dutch Oven II \$8.00 (Advanced) Arvil Sale 2 session course AM only**

This is a classroom and outdoor course for leaders familiar with cooking with a Dutch oven. This course is one step up from our basic DO course. This course is limited to 10 leaders. Register early. An extra fee of \$8.00 will be added to your registration. This course runs through session 1 & 2. Leaders in this course will eat what is prepared by both DO teams.

**OC3 Backpacking: Trail Magic Mac McCormick**

This course is for Leaders new to backpacking and old hands looking for a few new ideas. Learn not only how to keep yourself and your scouts safe and healthy but also **COMFORTABLE** in all seasons and weather conditions. Sample a trail meal. Bring your gear if you like and share your own tips and stories of trail magic with the class.

**OC4 Map & Compass Chuck Kirby**

Learn how to use a compass with a map and find your way in the woods (or anywhere else). Bring your own compass or a compass will be supplied. There will be a short practical exercise so be prepared to spend some time in the weather.

**OC5 Axe yard/Toten Chip Crew 919**

This course is for adult leaders in Cub and Boy Scouts charged with teaching young cubs and scouts with the proper handling of both the ax and knife. Learn the proper way to set up an ax yard, sharpen woods tools and safely/effectively conduct your own unit –level training.

**OC6 Planning a Northern Tier/ Philmont Trek made EASY Doug McGlasson**

This course is for Leaders dreaming of taking their unit on a high adventure trek of a lifetime. It covers the entire process from initial registration until returning home. Learn a canoe full of tips and take away a backpack full of lessons-learned.

**OC7 GPS I (Basic) Gene Crouse**

Basic GPS tracking where the leaders learn to operate a GPS instrument and are shown how to plot and find way points in the field to help the leader find his way in the woods (or anywhere else). We will also learn about Geoscouting the partnership of Scouting and Geocaching to help promote recruiting, retention, advancement and public relations of your Scouting Pack, Troop or Crew.

**OC8 Yakin River Keepers Dean**

This guy is from the Yakin River Keepers, they will instruct you on the up-keep and paddling the Yadkin River.
