DIRECTIONS and MAP

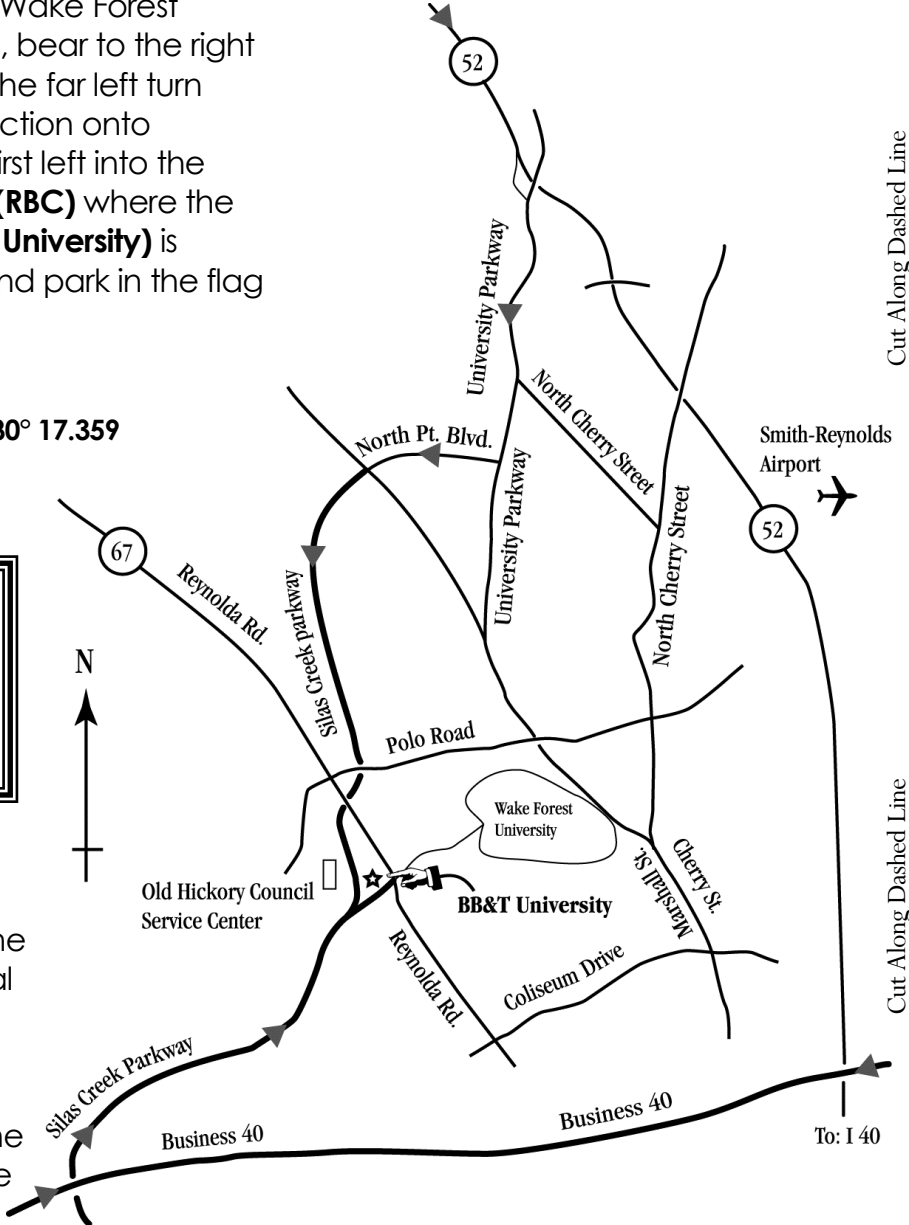
From Highway 40 Business (East or West), take the Silas Creek Parkway North exit. Continue on Silas Creek Parkway for approximately 3 miles following the signs to Wake Forest University. As the road forks, bear to the right and immediately get into the far left turn lane. Turn left at the intersection onto Reynolda Road. Take the first left into the **Reynolda Business Center (RBC)** where the **BB&T Training Center (BB&T University)** is located. Follow the signs and park in the flag island area.
