
In 2019, the Old Hickory Council will host Wood Badge course S7-427-19. This is a world class training experience available to all registered adults in Boy Scouts of America.

## Wood Badge - Is a Two Step Process



### What Takes Place

Wood Badge is the premier adult leadership development course for the Boy Scouts of America. Contemporary leadership and team building skills are taught in a comfortable indoor and outdoor setting, where learners become members of their own troop.

Wood Badge is more than a classroom; it's entertaining, fun games, hands-on projects, team building, and inspirational events. You will come away with an appreciation of Scouting's heritage, as well as a vision of the role you will play in its future, and the impact you will make on the youth in your own unit, the district and your council. Participation in this course will provide skills to help you achieve success in other aspects of your life... like home, or in your career!

### Part I—The Practical Experience

Wood Badge begins with six days of practical experiences, consisting of three days focused primarily on indoor experience followed by another three days of outdoor experience. Those participating are exposed to leadership and teambuilding

skills as they apply primarily to adults; but the training parallels the same skills and terminology taught by the National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT).

To demonstrate an understanding of the leadership skills taught at the course, each participant writes their vision of their future in scouting outlining how they will apply the leadership lessons learned in their specific role in Scouting after the practical experience.



### Part II—The Application Phase

The outdoor experience is followed by a period of up to eighteen months during which the Scouter applies the skills learned during the practical experience in his or her Scouting position – at the unit, district, or council level. Through this period each Scout-

er is assigned a counselor who acts as a resource and Scouting mentor to assist the participant in putting into action those points discussed during the course.

### WHO IS QUALIFIED?

To take Wood Badge you must:

- Be a registered member of the BSA. (Youth 18 and older may attend as long as the appropriate Youth Protection guidelines are followed. They do not need to be registered in an adult leadership role.)
- Have completed the basic training courses for your Scouting position,
- Be capable of functioning safely in an outdoor environment, have BSA Health Form Parts A,B and C,
- And lastly, have a desire to learn and participate in a FUN, interactive environment.
