Payment Schedule:

- \$300 Deposit at time of registration
- \$600 Payment #1 by June 1st, 2025 (\$900 total paid)
- \$600 Payment #2 by September 1st, 2025 (\$1,500 total paid)
- \$600 Payment #3 by December 1st, 2025 (\$2,100 total paid)

At the Summit

Housing: Each participant will be assigned a tentmate (appropriate Youth Protection Guidelines will be followed) for the 10 day period. Tents will be double occupancy only, and each tent will have two cots. Tents will be provided by the Old Hickory Council, the footprint of the tent will be no larger than 10ftx10ft.

Food: All food and cooking supplies will be provided by the National Jamboree. Scouts & leaders will be responsible for cooking their meals in the camp. For dietary restrictions the following will be accommodated: religious restrictions such as, kosher, halal, celiac, and nut allergies will be honored. Gluten free and vegetarian are “lifestyle” choices; they are not included but menus will address ingredients and notifications guiding those participants choosing to avoid items.
